We now confront the brutal reality of women being forced to carry dead fetuses, jailed for miscarriages, and undergoing hysterectomies after being denied abortions. Women deserve the fundamental right to bodily autonomy— to control our own bodies and destinies without government interference. We urge women across the political spectrum to unite and vote in 2024 as if our lives truly depend on it. This is not about party lines; it's about basic human rights."
